## **Custom Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Park Tours**



Join long time professional nature & wildlife photographer D. Robert Franz for an individualized day of instruction in the field. His award winning photography has been seen in nearly every nature publication in the world. He's had over ten thousand images published along with nearly 200 magazine covers. This is guaranteed to be a high energy, hands on workshop designed for aspiring nature photographers who want to dramatically improve their technical ability. Robert will divulge many of his techniques and style. He will show you how to obtain professional quality nature and wildlife images. Robert will try to increase the participants visionary skills, proficiency with their photo equipment, and their natural history understanding. So results can be seen immediately and the learning experience maximized, digital cameras are recommended, though not required.

One on one instruction is a powerful learning tool. Participants will be able to live a day in the life of a professional nature photographer. I can teach in both Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Park. I would only be available for Grand Teton from late May though October. I would suggest arranging your dates as early as possible. Rooms could be difficult to secure with short notice. For Yellowstone it would be best to base out of Gardiner or West Yellowstone MT. For Grand Teton National Park you would base out of Jackson WY.

I will take a maximum of 3 photographers. You may also arrange for me to come to your favorite location.

- \* Metering techniques; how to achieve consistently good exposures
- \* Equipment that makes a difference
- \* When and how to use flash as your main light or as fill light
- \* How to get professionally sharp images
- \* Proper AF and manual focusing techniques
- \* How to successfully capture action photos
- \* How to get over subject fixation
- \* Powerful compositional techniques
- \* What to look for in your background
- \* How to approach birds and wildlife without disturbance
- \* The ethics of nature photography



**Potential subjects include:**

Pronghorn antelope, elk, badger, mule deer, whitetail deer, trumpeter swans, black bears, grizzly bears, moose, eagles, otters, bison, bighorn sheep, waterfowl, wolves, coyotes, thermal features, mountains scenes, wildflowers. lakes, and rivers.
